RULES

Division	I	Oils, acrylics, mixed media
Division	II	Watercolor, graphics, drawings, and pastels
Division	III	Photography
Division	IV	Three dimensional fine arts – original work in sculpture, stained glass, jewelry, pottery, textiles, etc.
Division	V	Hobbies and crafts. Entries cannot be imported items or copies of imports that are available commercially. Crafter may be asked to remove these items if they are displayed at the Festival.

All exhibits must be suitable for one of the designated Divisions; that is, art related and in good taste. The Festival Committee reserves the right to reject unsuitable work. Artists may exhibit only their own work. All entries in Divisions I through IV must be original in design. Copies of the masters, advertisements or widely circulated photographs are not acceptable. **Pre-cast pottery, ceramics and beads made from commercial molds and anything made from kits are to be entered in Division V. Hobby and Craft entries may not be re-sales of imports and/or “ready made” items, etc.** Division designation may be changed at discretion of the jury. **A minimum of ten (10) exhibitors in a Division is required for awards. (If there are less than ten entries in Division III they will be judged with Division II.) No piece having won an award in any prior Festival of the Arts show will be accepted for judging. No ribbons previously won in any show may be displayed.**

The work of only one exhibitor may be displayed in each assigned space. A team producing a single product such as jewelry, ceramics, leather, fiber, etc. may qualify as a single exhibitor; however, such team may consist of no more than two people. **Be sure that both artists sign the application.**

Exhibitors may enter more than one Division, but a separate fee is required for each additional Division entered in the same space. Division V may not be exhibited in the same spaces as Divisions I through IV (whether or not work is to be judged). Additional spaces require full fee. The exhibitor is responsible for his/her own display. Spaces may not be exchanged, shared or sold. All displays are to be neat and orderly with tables skirted and packing materials out of sight. Exhibit spaces measure approximately 12' x 12'. Artist's setup, including browse boxes and chairs, must be contained within this assigned space and **not on the sidewalk. Stakes are not permitted! Be prepared to set up without them.**

There will be security provided at the site from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. Friday and Saturday, November 3th and November 4th. You may be interested in setting up your display the night before the show. Staggered times for early setup will be determined by order of applications received and area assigned. Your acceptance letter will indicate the time you may begin setting up. Committee members will be available to answer questions Friday afternoon/evening. If you have questions, please check in at the desk **before** setting up your exhibit. If you leave your artwork overnight, you do so at your own risk. The Festival of the Arts Committee and the sponsors accept no responsibility or liability for damage or loss. On Saturday, the registration desk will open at 7:30 a.m. Please pick up your registration packet before 9:00 a.m. Exhibits must be ready for judging by 9:30 a.m. and remain in place until 4:30 p.m. Saturday and **4:00 p.m. Sunday.** Dollies may be necessary to move your artwork and setup to your assigned space. Dollies are not available from the committee. You must be prepared to set up and break down without help from the committee. All vehicles must be removed from the exhibit area by 9 a.m. Parking will be permitted in the designated areas only.

The following are not allowed in the exhibition area: solicitation, sound equipment, pets, and alcoholic beverages. Vehicles are not permitted to return before 4:30 p.m. Saturday and **4:00 p.m. Sunday** and on Sunday will require a voucher for entry to the exhibit area. If you do not stay for the entire show, or if you do not follow established procedures, you may not be accepted next year.

Ribbons will be awarded individually on Saturday to allow for display of ribbons on art works. Checks will be distributed by the Committee on Sunday afternoon.

Collection of and remittance of sales tax to the State of Florida is the responsibility of each artist.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Applications must be received by September 15th. Artists accepted will be notified by email of acceptance and then by mail after September 30th when space is assigned. Applicants not accepted by the jury will be notified immediately after being juried. Spaces will be assigned by the Registrar on a first come basis. Requests for previous spaces will be honored, if available, until August 1st.

Three (3) photos representative of the art/craft you wish to enter and one photo of the display are required. Write your name and the date on the back of each photo. Artists who received cash awards in the 2016 Festival of the Arts, including Purchase Awards, are not required to submit \$10 jury fee if entering in the same division; however, you must submit a self-addressed, stamped envelope for the return of information pertinent to acceptance and to assignment of space. All acceptances are the result of decisions by the jurors and their decisions are final. All photos will be returned by mail.

Two checks or money orders made payable to The Festival of the Arts Committee, Inc. should be submitted with your application: (1) a \$10 per Division non-refundable jury fee; and (2) a space fee as shown below. Mail to: P.O. Box 2383, Inverness, FL 34451-2383
